**JOHN DUTY COLLINS III OUTSTANDING ADVOCATE  
FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES AWARD 2024**

The Alexandria Commission on Persons with Disabilities (ACPD) is pleased to announce its call for nominations for the John Duty Collins III Outstanding Advocate for Persons with Disabilities Award.

The award was established in 1989 in memory of John Duty Collins III, a founder and Vice Chair of the ACPD. During his lifetime Mr. Collins worked tirelessly to improve accessibility in facilities throughout Alexandria, including the Courthouse, City Hall, and Chinquapin Center. Mr. Collins also served as co-chair of the task force that established the DOT Paratransit program.

The award, which will be presented at a reception on Wednesday, June 26, 2024, at 5:00 p.m., includes a \$500 donation to an organization, chosen by the recipient, that promotes equal opportunity for persons with disabilities within the City of Alexandria. Funding for the John Duty Collins III Outstanding Advocate Award is provided by the Collins Family.
