- 1. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Virtual meeting requirements read by Tiffany Pache.
- 3. Welcome by David Spinrad.
- Descendant Research Update presented by Audrey Davis. Two genealogists hired: Char McCargo Bah Thomas has leads that she is following up on. Leslie Anderson McCoy has a lead and is travelling to try and confirm.
- 5. The April 23 will be a remembrance for McCoy, but not a soil collection. It will be the first large public event for McCoy.
- 6. Soil Collection for McCoy and Thomas led by Gretchen Bulova
 - OHA staff traveled to EJI in Montgomery on a on fact finding mission in early March. Discussed information related to soil collection:
 - i. There is an application process we must adhere to for the soil collection.
 - ii. Strong desire to include descendants in soil collection and pilgrimage.
 - iii. Soil collection needs to take place no later than mid-September
 - iv. Proposing to combine soil collection, rather than two individual events
 - v. Discussion followed and the committee agreed with the joint ceremony.
 - Soil ceremony at EJI is able to take place in the auditorium at the National Memorial for Peace and Justice, where the pillars are located.
 - Ceremony tentatively planned for Friday, Oct 7 at 10 a.m.
 - The Mayor of Alexandria is able to join ACRP for this soil ceremony.
- 7. Update on EJI markers presented by Gretchen Bulova
 - We had been under the impression we would only get one marker, but that is no

longer the case.

- Application for EJI markers is now through the VA Department of Historic Resources.
- Ideas for markers include the two lynching locations, the original police station, the jail, and Penny Hill Cemetery.
