4. Planning and Zoning Report

- a. At the 12/14/2024 City Council public hearing, City Council upheld the BAR decision to deny window changes at 201 Gibbon Street.
- b. The Preservation Architect, Bill Conkey, is working closely with General Services and the project architects on the restoration/renovation of City Hall and Market Square. They held a workshop in City Hall on Monday, Jan 13. Once the concept is further along, it will go to the BAR.
- c. Development projects that will begin this year include 78 condo units at 805 N. Columbus. This will eventually incorporate the development at 802-808 N Washington, where the historic house was moved to become part of the new building. Another is at 1101 King, where 200 units plus retail will be developed (this is currently an office building).
- d. Projects with affordable housing Samuel Madden (899 N. Henry) and Heritage (900 Wolfe) will also break ground this year.
- e. Tonight the BAR will hear 10 cases, plus a concept review for 802/808 N. Washington, and updates to the Design Guidelines: awnings/canopies and signs. Zoning staff is working on updating the signs ordinance in general. These new BAR guidelines will comply with the new ordinance.
