 - -The first concept review for the renovation/update of City Hall will go to the BAR on April 16. There will be one or two more concept reviews before it comes to the BAR for a Certificate of Appropriateness. City staff will be moved out of City Hall in January of 2026.
 - -A concept review for Point Lumley Park at 3 Duke Street will go to the BAR on May 7. The proposal requests to create a new, more welcoming park here with seating, a shade structure, a promenade, a kayak launch, and a floating wetland. This is on the north side of Duke Street at the river, south of ODBC.
 - -The Heritage project at 505 S. Alfred will begin construction in the second quarter of 2025.
 - -The Braddock West project at 727 N. West has requested an extension of their Development Special Use Permit, which was originally approved in 2020.
 - -The pump station to be built for waterfront flood mitigation will be located in Waterfront Park, but the exact location is not yet determined. The design will go to the BAR for another concept review in June. Like City Hall and Lumley Park, it will likely need more than one Concept Review before final BAR approval.
