 - Sheet passed out of proposed names that will be submitted to HARC to vote yes or no.

 - Note that Ladray's name is misspelled on the sheet
 - Note- Spengler is misspelled- brother works for the City Of Alexandria
 - Parker-Gray honorary street, so naming after Gray/Parker might be an issue
 - Street names that are also in Fairfax County, city council has spoken about it, no decision as of yet
 - \circ $\;$ Will increase amount of names shared with HARC since there is a deadline
 - Suggestions
 - Margaret Brent- but there is a court named for her
 - Linda read the tribes that do have street names and those that do not have street names
 - Chickahominy, Mattaponi, Nansemond, Pamunkey- very active in Alexandria
 - There are streets that have indigenous flower and fauna names
 - James Lewis- from Lee/Fendell House
 - Canarie Quander- worked in household of John Lewis
 - Scyphax- descendants of George Park Lee Custis
- 3. Public comment-

- Amy Burch- works for COA but here as member of public, wanted to suggest Durr in honor of Clifford and Virginia Durr very involved in improving conditions in the South. Virginia oversaw abolishing poll tax. Cliff work for feds and resigned when he felt pressure to take oath of loyalty of red scare
 - Born and raised in Alabama
 - Came active in Civil Rights Movement
 - 4018 Seminary Road- still exists
 - She would like to see Donaldson Street renamed
 - House is located across the street from Frost Street
- 4. Committee suggestions continued
 - Loving lawyers- Cohen and Hirschkop
 - Benjamin Halloway
- 5. COA announcements
 - Scope of work will be going to City Council on May 23
 - Naming committee on Monday and they are okay with scope of work going forward
