If ARTC is not a medically-appropriate option, assistance in accessing services will be provided.

For those who use intermittently or that have recently begun establishing abstinence, call Central Intake at 703.746.3535 to schedule an intake to assess needs and preferences.

For those addicted to heroin or other opioids such as Oxycontin or Percocet who are interested in medication-assisted treatment, call 703.746.3600 and ask to speak to the Opioid Treatment Intake Coordinator





Residential Treatment Services

The Alexandria Residential Treatment Center (ARTC) provides community-based intensive clinical services in a structured residential setting for individuals (age 18+) who are unable to avoid using alcohol or drugs in ways that create serious problems in their lives.

ARTC Phase 1 allows these individuals to interrupt their cycle of use and stabilize. Support and/or referrals are provided to address health, mental health, housing or other barriers to stability.

Participants in ARTC Phase 2 identify goals for ongoing stability, health and recovery and work toward those goals through an intensive program of residential, clinical and peer support.

To support smooth transition back to the community, those in Phase 2 also engage in ongoing treatment through the SA Outpatient and/ or Opioid Treatment programs. Psychiatric medication management and case management services are also available.

Anyone who is unable to stop using alcohol or illicit drugs, or who has experienced problems associated with their use, may benefit from treatment. The cost of services is based on income.

Outpatient Services

Outpatient Services offers adults (18+) a combination of treatment services that help reduce symptoms of their substance use disorder, enhance stability, engage in recovery and improve their lives.

- A variety of group treatment options
- Individual therapy
- Psychiatric services
- Case management
- Peer recovery services
- Access to community services

Outpatient Services are most helpful for those whose substance use creates problems in their lives, but who have a stable place to live and support for making changes.

Opioid Treatment Program

The Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) adds medication to the Outpatient Services. Therapy plus medication (Suboxone, Methadone) is the best treatment for those who are addicted to opioids.

Through engagement in the program, adults (18+) develop a satisfying life free of illicit drugs. The medication, which is prescribed and monitored by medical and nursing staff, removes the cravings to use while therapy allows clients to learn relapse prevention skills and develop a recovery plan, improving their overall health. Some may be able to successfully stop the prescribed medication; others may need ongoing medication assisted treatment.

Services for Family and Friends

For those whose friends or loved ones are concerned and/or supportive of their recovery, these options are available:

Concerned Persons Support

Understanding Recovery

This free 12-week recovery education group is open to clients as well as to family or friends. It is held twice on Wednesdays from 11 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. or from 6 -7:15 p.m.

12 Step Support

The Substance Use Treatment Center provides space for a number of weekly community self-help support groups such as Alanon, NA, AA, Smart Recovery, MA, CA and Bridging the Gap. Call for more information.
