FREE COVID-19 TESTING IS AVAILABLE IN ALEXANDRIA!

COVID-19 symptoms can seem like other common illnesses. If you are not feeling well, or you have been around someone who has COVID-19, get tested. You can stop the spread to friends and loved ones.

WHEN TO GET TESTED:

- If you have COVID-19 symptoms, get tested immediately
- If you have been exposed to COVID-19:
 - Fully vaccinated people should get tested 5-7 days after exposure, and monitor themselves for symptoms for 14 days. If symptoms develop, get re-tested.
 - <u>Unvaccinated people</u> should be tested immediately, and stay away from others for 14 days. If the test comes back negative, get tested again 5–7 days after last exposure or immediately if symptoms develop during the 14 day quarantine.

WHERE TO GET TESTED:

Curative kiosks are free and don't require ID or insurance.
