



FREE COVID-19 TESTING IS AVAILABLE IN ALEXANDRIA!

COVID-19 symptoms can seem like other common illnesses. If you are not feeling well, or you have been around someone who has COVID-19, get tested. You can stop the spread to friends and loved ones.

WHEN TO GET TESTED:

- If you have COVID-19 symptoms, get tested immediately
- If you have been exposed to COVID-19:
 - **Fully vaccinated people** should get tested 5-7 days after exposure, and monitor themselves for symptoms for 14 days. If symptoms develop, get re-tested.
 - **Unvaccinated people** should be tested immediately, and stay away from others for 14 days. If the test comes back negative, get tested again 5-7 days after last exposure or immediately if symptoms develop during the 14 day quarantine.

WHERE TO GET TESTED:
