## Attachment – Mission Statement Subcommittee Report

Alexandria-Caen Sister City Committee Mission Statement Subcommittee Report July 19, 2021

#### Foundational Authorities:

There are two foundational authorities for the Alexandria-Caen Sister City Committee: the Mission Statement of Sister Cities International and the City of Alexandria Code of Ordinances. If a signed agreement between Alexandria and Caen exists we were unable to access it.

- Mission Statement of Sister Cities International: "To promote peace through mutual respect, understanding, and cooperation—one individual, one community at a time.":
- City of Alexandria Code of Ordinances:<sup>2</sup>

"The functions, powers and duties of the [Alexandria-Caen Sister City] committee shall be to advise and support the city and the city council as to:

- economic development and tourism programs, academic/educational student and staff
  exchanges, arts and cultural program exchanges, and professional health program
  exchanges, between the City of Alexandria, Virginia and the City of Caen, France, and the
  residents thereof:
- (2) to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out the responsibilities expressly given in this subsection; and
- (3) such other tasks as may be requested by the city council."

#### Proposed Mission Statement:

"As part of Sister Cities International, the Alexandria-Caen Sister City Committee promotes friendship and cooperation' between Alexandria and Caen through educational, cultural, commercial, and professional exchanges and activities."

This breaks down into the following categories of activities:

- Educational: such as lecture programming in Alexandria on French/Norman/Caen topics.
- > Cultural: such as the D-Day commemorative program and the Beaujolais Nouveau program
- Commercial: No current activities.
- Professional: No current activities.
