Catherine Miliaras provided a brief overview of the project. The owner, Ari Karadacht, who described the intent to preserve the home as much as possible and to request support for the new easement. It will cover a wall encapsulation and exterior façade as part of the rehabilitation project to replace a 1990's addition to the dwelling which will move the kitchen from the basement to the first floor and add a second story to the new addition.

The easement should specify the process for ordinary maintenance. Approved unanimously.

A discussion on how easements are part of the preservation strategy for the City ensued. The Commission clarified that it will not routinely accept easements when requested by the BAR.
