- 3. Committee Work

a) Grand Marshal Update

Jeanne moved that for the GWBCC parade in February, we ask the various first responders and health care worker groups to serve as multiple Grand Marshals. Jason seconded and the committee unanimously approved. Jeanne, Tyler, Sue, and Claire will reach out to organizations to recruit participants from these various groups, including fire, police, and sectors of health care.

b) Event Planning for 2022

Claire confirmed the Old Presbyterian Meeting House will host a Wreath Laying Ceremony. She will work on the program in early January.

Colonial Christmas Traditions will take place on Sunday, December 12, exact time TBD. Claire will handle the logistics and donate decorations and food items. Once Tyler confirms the location, he will provide details to Historic Alexandria for marketing in their weekly eNews.

Tyler walked through events currently planned for the 2022 celebration and updates he is making to the marketing flyer.

Sue noted the next George Washington's Alexandria Walking Tour is scheduled for November 28 at 2 p.m.

c) Fundraising

Sue is updating the sponsorship packet to reflect changes in events. She noted the importance of the coming weeks for fundraising. Tyler and Sue will be visiting businesses in person this week to share sponsorship opportunities.

d) Parade Registration
