

EAST BELLEFONTE AVENUE TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT

BETWEEN DEWITT AVENUE AND ROUTE 1—300, 400, & 500 BLOCKS



BACKGROUND

As part of the Bellefonte Avenue traffic calming project that was initiated by requests and a petition from the residents, the City of Alexandria will be installing speed cushions along Bellefonte Street between Dewitt Ave. and Route 1. Excessive speeding, where the 85th percentile speed was 5mph over the speed limit, was documented by the City on these blocks, and the street met the eligible criteria for speed cushions.

PROJECT PLANS

Three speed cushions will be installed on Bellefonte Street between Dewitt Avenue and Route 1.

- No parking will be removed due to the installation of speed cushion
- Speed cushions will not obstruct driveways
- Pending weather conditions, installation will likely take place in Spring 2017
- Speed, crash, and volume data to be collected and evaluated post-construction
