

# JORDAN STREET TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT

BETWEEN SEMINARY ROAD AND JUNIPER PLACE



## BACKGROUND

As part of the Jordan Street traffic calming project that was initiated by requests and a petition from the residents, the City of Alexandria will be installing speed cushions along Jordan Street between Seminary Road and Juniper Place. Excessive speeding, where the 85th percentile speed was 5mph over the speed limit, was documented by the City on these blocks, and the street met the eligible criteria for speed cushions.

## PROJECT PLANS

Three sets of speed cushions will be installed on Jordan Street between Seminary Road and Juniper Place.

- No parking will be removed due to the installation of speed cushion
- Speed cushions will not obstruct driveways
- Pending weather conditions, installation will likely take place in before the Winter of 2018.
- Speed, crash, and volume data to be collected and evaluated post-construction
