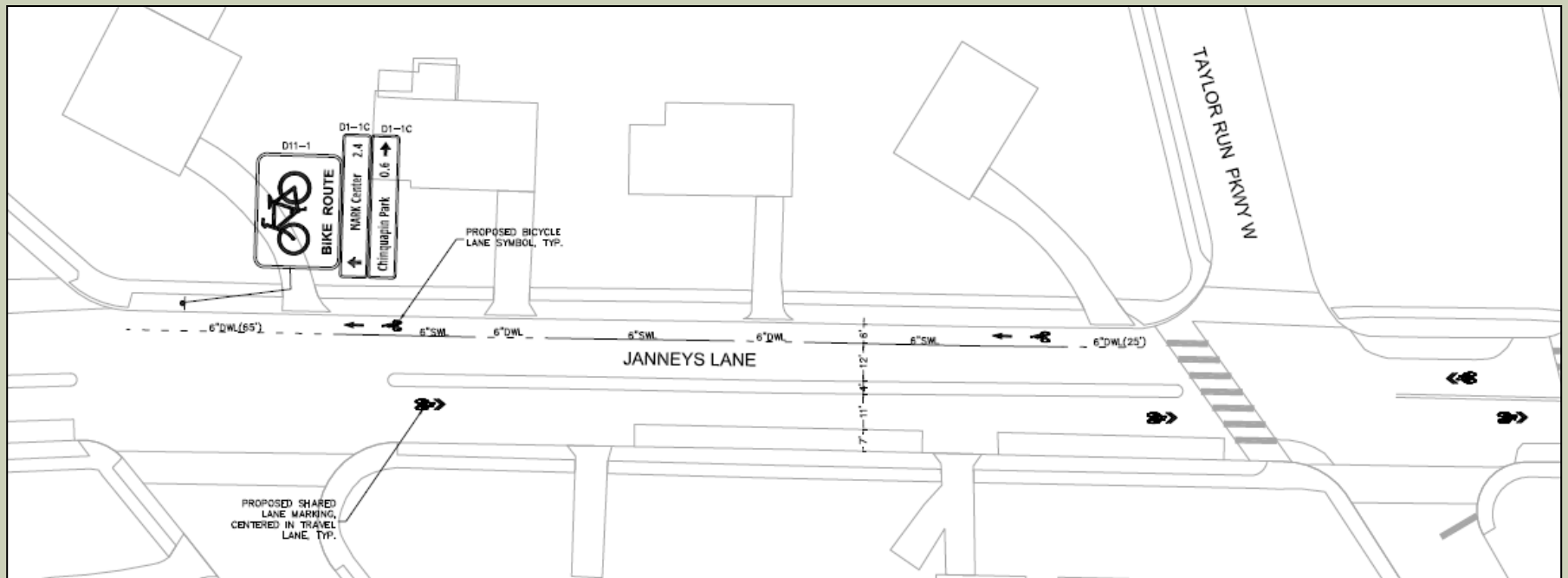

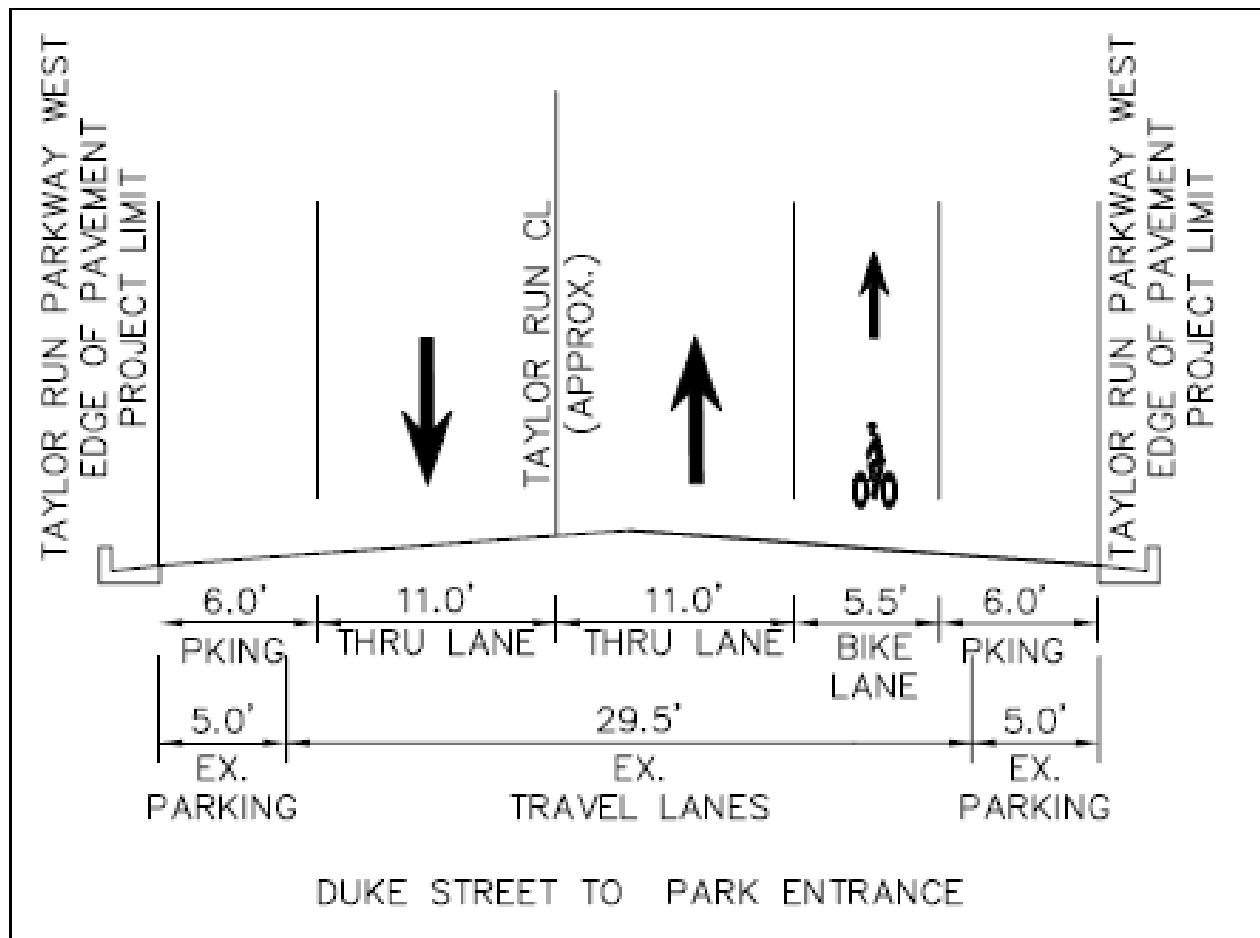
JANNEYS LANE BICYCLE LANES

- Climbing Lane EB to Taylor Run and WB to Quaker Lane
- Shared lanes in front of elementary school
- No parking or travel lane removal



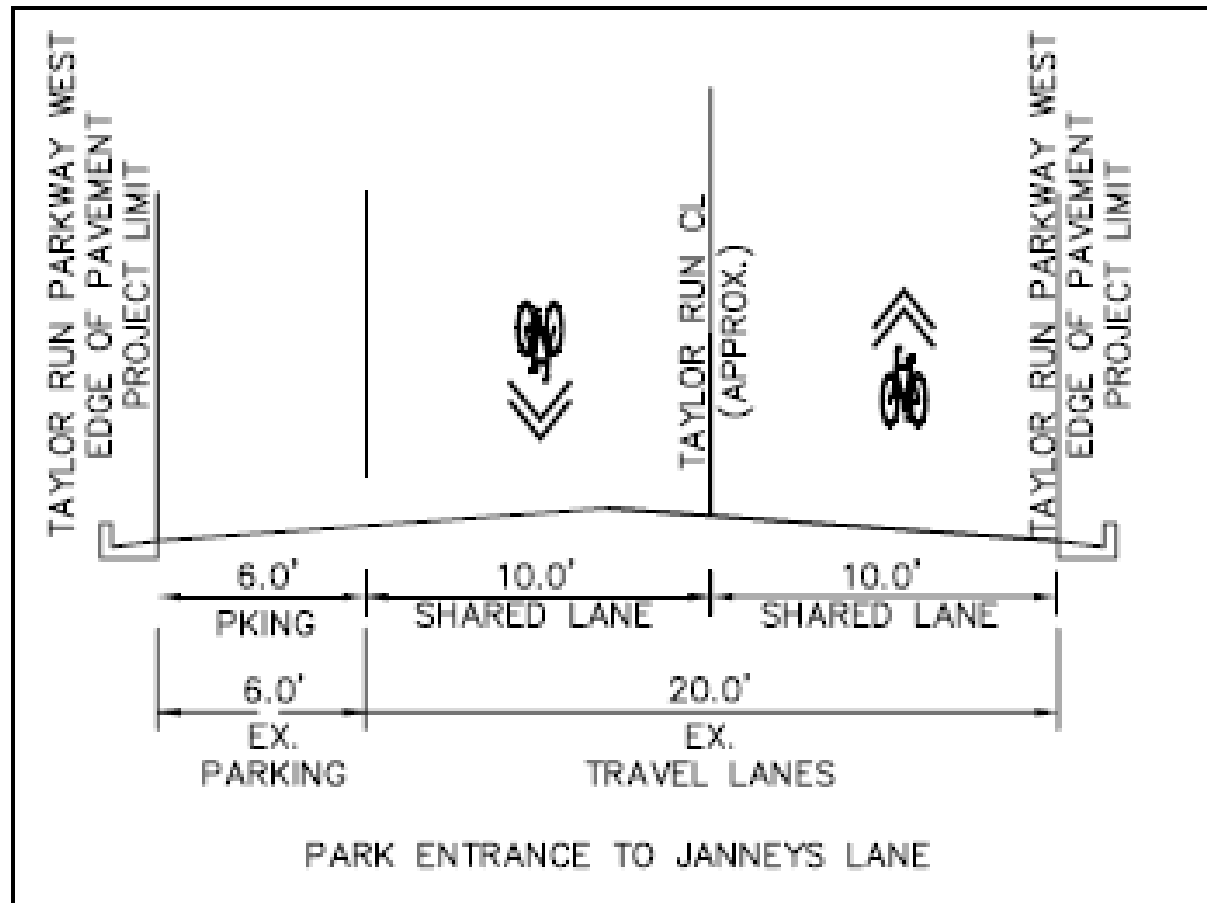
TAYLOR RUN BIKE FACILITIES: DUKE TO DARTMOUTH – CLIMBING LANE

ANGEL PARK ACCESS



- Create better access to Angel Park
 - Design ADA accessible curb extensions if feasible
 - Project in conjunction with Parks Department

UPLAND PLACE CROSSING

- Improve crossing at Upland Place and King Street
 - Safe Routes to School Project (Maury Elementary)
 - Upgrade crosswalks to high visibility



SIDEWALK REQUESTS

- Hilltop Terrace between Upland Place and Carlisle Street
 - Large Trees
 - Private Landscaping
 - Fencing

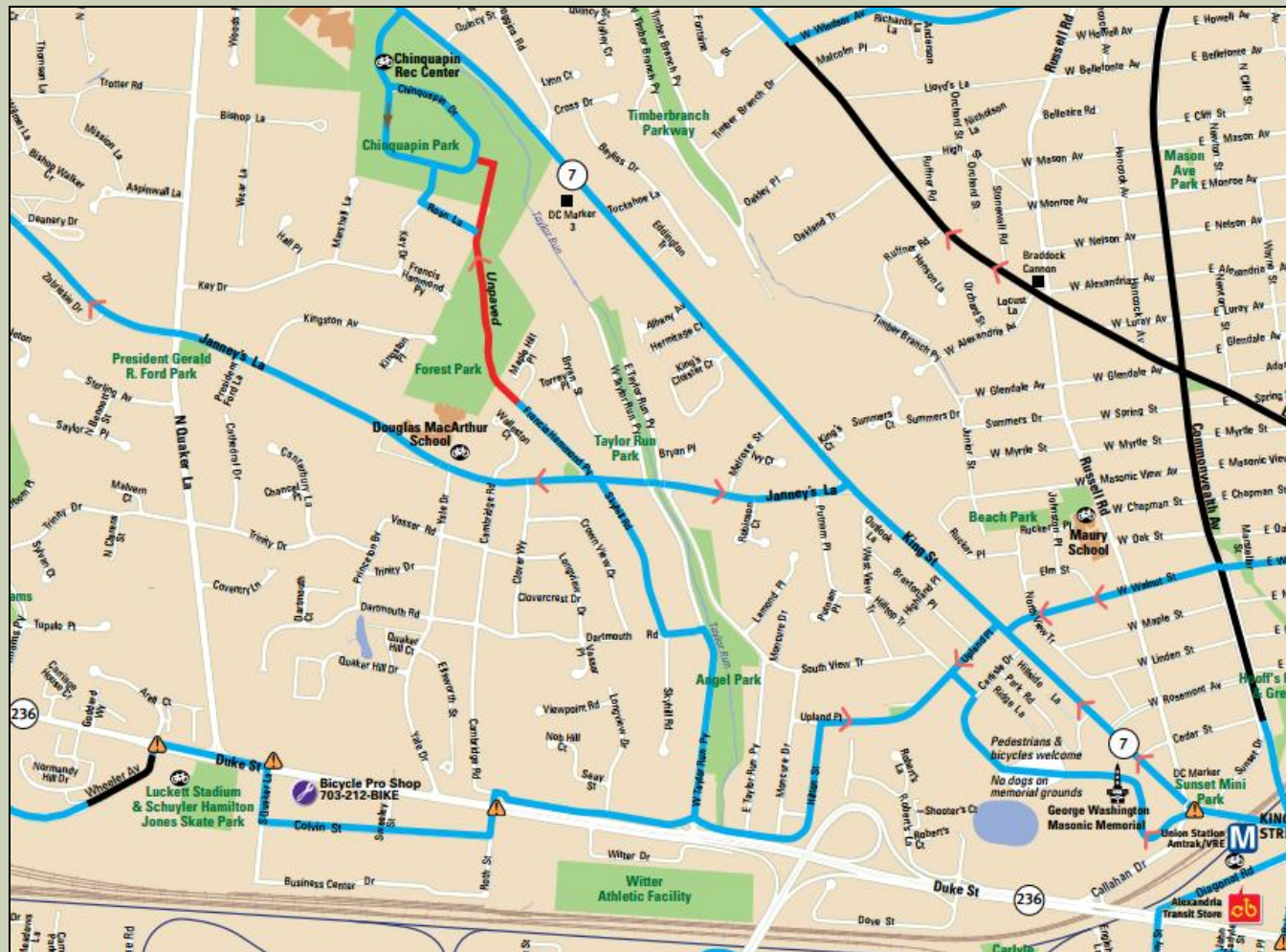


POSSIBLE PROJECT: KING STREET TRAFFIC CALMING & BICYCLE FACILITIES

- Climbing lane for northbound King Street to Janneys Lane
- Shared lane for southbound King Street to the Metro
