BIAG At-Large Positions Vacancy Replacement Process

"At-Large" slots represent an interest but are not tied to a group

- City staff will solicit candidates
- City staff will compile a list of nominees from the nomination submissions.
- City staff will provide the slate of nominees to the IAG, along with their application materials, and request feedback during an IAG business meeting.
- City staff will forward the list of nominees, their application materials, and the IAG's comments to the City Manager.
- The City Manager will select the replacement from the nominees and appoint the replacement to the at-large vacant slot.
