Each section of the assessment is a reflection of the total number of classrooms assessed and the total number of points the spaces achieved.

Each space receives an individual score and ranking based on the total number of points possible for the section.

The overall score is the sum of all the individual scores over the total points possible, multiplied by the number of rooms assessed.

Therefore, the overall unweighted score is not an average score, rather it is reflective of the subtotal of all spaces.

This means that an overall score may result in a satisfactory rating, meaning the majority of the classrooms meet between 70 and 89 percent of the assessment criteria; but not all spaces may rate satisfactory. One space can rate very inadequate while all spaces rate excellent.
