13.2.01 POLICY AND PURPOSE

Hazardous materials are used in, or pass through the city almost daily by air, rail and highway. The presence of the major railroad switching complexes/tracks, several large truck shipping terminals and National Airport provides the potential for a large-scale hazardous materials incident.



The purpose of this directive is to provide guidelines in the event of a hazardous materials incident.

13.2.02 DEFINITIONS

<u>CHEMTREC</u> - an acronym for the Chemical Transportation Emergency Center, which is provided as a public service by the Chemical Manufacturer's Association. It is designed to provide immediate information to public safety officials facing a chemical

transportation emergency.

<u>Hazardous Material</u> - a substance or material capable of endangering life, health, safety, property and/or the environment.

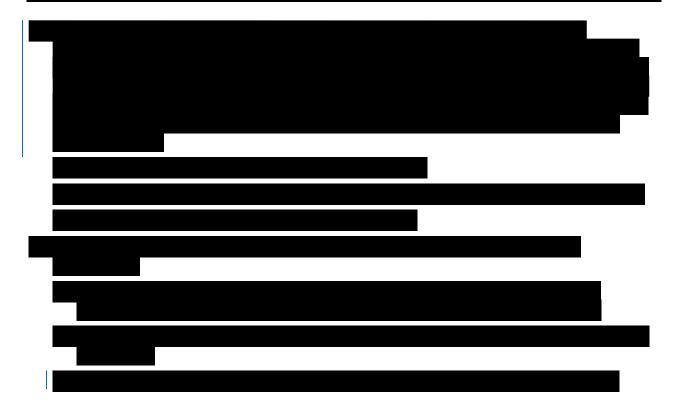
<u>Hazardous Materials Incident</u> - the actual or potential leaking, spilling or burning of hazardous materials.

<u>HAZMAT</u> - the Hazardous Materials Response Team staff by firefighters specializing in hazardous materials emergencies.

13.2.03 RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. The Fire Department has primary control in handling:
 - 1. Fire suppression;
 - 2. Rescue; and
 - 3. Containment.
- B. The Police Department has primary control in handling:
 - 1. Securing of the area;
 - 2. Traffic control; and
 - 3. Evacuation.
