What should I do after a car crash?

Check for injuries

Check yourself, passengers, and those involved for injuries.

Call 911 for emergencies.

Move cars out of traffic

If safe to do so, move cars to the shoulder of the road way.

Turn on your hazard lights.

Call the police

Officer can respond to crashes.

Reports are only taken when:

- Injury or death occurs
- \$1,500+ damage occurs
- Hit and run cases

Exchange information

You are legally required to exchange information if you are involved in a crash, regardless of the severity of the damage.

Driver and Passengers: name, address, phone numbers.

Insurance: company name, policy number, telephone number, does the car match information?

Car: license plate, make, model, take pictures of all damage.--
