Background – Council Actions

City Council adopted the Management Plan on January 24, 2015:

- Requested a Work Session to discuss the Plan implementation process
- Requested a new monitoring group for the implementation of the approved Plan
- Approved \$1,395,000 for Plan implementation in FY2016 –2025 CIP, including \$200,000 in FY2016





Updates on Stormwater Management,
 Interpretive Plan, Oral History, and Grave
 Location Research

 Discussed the makeup of the new Plan Implementation Monitoring Group

 On June 10, 2015, Council approved the creation of the new Monitoring Group



Charge of the Monitoring Group

Meet at least quarterly with staff from RPCA, OHA and T&ES to:

- Provide recommendations to staff for the implementation of the approved Plan
- Review and monitor implementation projects for consistency with approved Plan
- Provide recommendations on park uses/operations for consistency with approved Plan
- Participate in the development of an annual update on Plan implementation



Membership of the Monitoring Group

Eleven Member Group:

- One Council member appointed by the Mayor and serving as the convener of the Group
- Ten members appointed by the City Manager
 - Nine members recommended by chairs of the City commissions, and leadership of the Oakland Baptist Church, Descendants Society and civic associations
 - One at-large member appointed after call for nominations



Drainage Master Plan

- Stormwater study conducted in June 2014 prepared by URS Corp.
- Recommended Three Improvements (in order of priority)
 - Stormwater diversion at Oakland Baptist Church Cemetery
 - Stormwater improvements at parking lot off Braddock Road
 - Streambank stabilization

 - Agreed on next steps
 - Working with Oakland's Consultant

 - View/Discuss Alignment
 - Revised to save trees
- July 29, 2015 @ Ft Ward Park
 - 2nd Stakeholder Workshop
 - View/Discuss Revised Alignment
 - Consensus reached to move forward with Archaeology
- September 3, 2015 @ Ft Ward Park
 - Stakeholder Workshop Archaeology
 - Lead by OHA View/Discuss Proposed Archaeology

Project Related Archaeology

- OHA to conduct Archaeologic Investigations (October 2015)

Finalize Design

- Consensus on Concept Design
- Timeline: Started Concurrent with Archaeology

Preparation of Construction Documents

- Finalize Plans/Specifications for construction contractor
- Timeline: Three Four Months (Q1 of 2016)

Procurement (Advertise & Award)

- Timeline: Three Months (Q2 of 2016)


Construction

- Timeline: Three Months (Q3 of 2016)
- Approximately \$500,000 (approved budget)

Interpretive Planning Process

- City Council approved \$150,000 in FY 2016 Capital Budget
- Capital funds will allow additional archaeological work and development of the Interpretive Plan
- Fort Ward Interpretive Plan Advisory Committee will be established to:
 - Help coordinate the RFP process
 - Select historical themes and stories
 - Identify appropriate interpretive tools and programs
 - Best connect the history of Fort Ward to broader aspects of city, regional and national heritage
- Future updates to Implementation Monitoring Group




Park Area Maintenance / Enhancements

- The Dog Park has been removed per the approved Plan
- Removal of tree stumps continues
- Tree work planned for this winter:
 - Remove 42 dead trees, trim 53 trees
- \$50,000 in CIP Funding (FY2016) for:
 - Plant 24 new trees this fall/winter
 - > ADA compliant benches and picnic tables
 - Accessible (ADA) parking and pathways
- Maintenance & Enhancements coordinated with OHA per MOU
