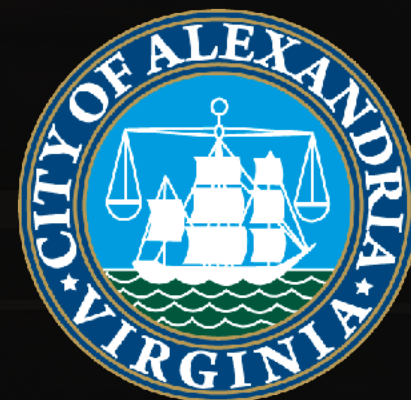

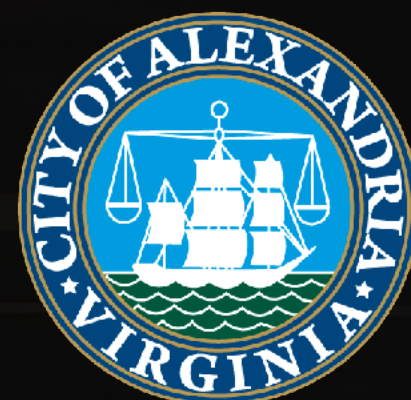
Proposal

Citizens

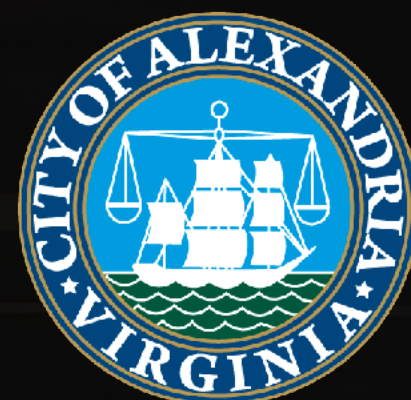
Next steps
