

## Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP)



2000: City of Alexandria entered into the VRP Program

Boom installed

2003: Free Product Recovery

2006: Relining of Oronoco St. Storm Sewer Pipe

2014: BioSparge GroundwaterTreatment System installed Relined additional Oronoco St. Storm Sewer Pipe

2017: Installed additional recovery well

#### **Dredge and Cap Project Objective**



- Dredge and remove contaminated sediment from around the Oronoco St. storm sewer outfall.
- Backfill it with clean sand.
- Installing reactive cap to prevent seeps from entering into the river.







#### **Environmental Controls**



- Air Monitoring
  - Within Work Zone
  - Outside Work Zone
- Odors Managed
- Turbidity Monitored

#### **Lane Closure**



- Oronoco Street between N. Union Street and the river will be closed for the duration of the project.
- Material will be transported to and from the jobsite via barges.

### **Project Schedule**





- Mobilization (Dec. Jan.)
- Dredging (Jan. Feb.)
- Capping (Feb. March)
